

THE BEST OF SOUTHEAST CHINA (5D4N SHANGHAI - SUZHOU - HANGZHOU MUSLIM TOUR)

Day 1 : KL - Shanghai - Hangzhou (L/D)

Arrive in Shanghai in the morning. After a warm welcome, we will head to Hangzhou. What makes the city "Paradise on Earth" is its world renowned **West Lake**. Divided into 5 sub-lakes by two causeways and one hill, the perfect mixture of mountains, lakes, bridges and architectures has won countless praises around the world. A **cruise** will be provided to take us into the picturesque world. Today's prayers will be held at **Phoenix Mosque** - one of the four ancient Mosques in China. Check into hotel for rest.



Day 2 : Hangzhou - Suzhou (B/L/D)

A tour to **Flower Harbor Park** - one of the eight traditional spotlights at West Lake will open a brand new day, followed by a visit to **Tea House**, where you will be presented the best Dragon Well Tea. We will head to Suzhou after lunch. **Suzhou** is a city with over 2,500 years of history and was regarded by Marco Polo as the "Venice of the Orient". The first place to visit is **Golden Rooster Lake Scenic Area**. As China's largest urban lake park, its multi-functionality is also worth a visit. Besides natural sites, there's museums, conference center, malls, amusement park and gourmets. Check into hotel before dinner. In the evening, we will have a casual walk along **Guan Qian Street** - the most famous cultural street in Suzhou.



Day 3 : Suzhou - Shanghai (B/L/D)

To see the historic Suzhou, **The Couple's Garden** (also named Ouyuan Garden) is the best place to explore. It was originally built in early Qing Dynasty, and expanded in 1874 by a government officer, intending to retreat with his beloved wife. A **boat tour** there will take you into a world of exquisiteness and tranquillity. Stop by at **Silk Store** to get the best products. Take private coach to Shanghai - Paris of the Orient. A stroll to **The Bund** and **Nan Jing Shopping Road** will be the appetizer to explore this wonderful city, followed by a free foot massage at **Herbal Medicine Center** to ensure a better rest.



Day 4 : Shanghai (B/L/D)



Another spotlight can't be missed is **Shanghai Old Town**. Originally built in early Ming Dynasty (more than 600 years ago), it consists of buildings of fabulous styles. It has also been serving as a window to present China's glorious culture. The next stop is **People's Square** - located in the city center, this square is surrounded by Shanghai government, Shanghai Grand Theater, City Planning Center etc and is known as the symbol of Shanghai. After lunch, we will pray at **Xiao Tao Yuan Mosque** - the most famous Mosque in Shanghai. After some shopping time at **Jade Center** and **Bamboo Carbon Shop**, we will take a look at **Shanghai New World** - a wonderful mix of the old and the new.

Day 5 : Shanghai - KL (B/L)

Check out in the morning. The time before will be devoted to the most popular **Qipu Road Market** - the best place to have the fun of bargaining. Transfer to Pudong International Airport for the departure flight home.
